1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Education – Public Schools – Standardized Course Numbering System**

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the State Department of Education to develop a
4 standardized course numbering system to facilitate the collection of data on
5 student participation in courses offered in the public schools; authorizing each
6 county school system to adopt the standardized course numbering system on a
7 voluntary basis; requiring a certain county school system to provide a
8 translation of course numbers under certain circumstances; and generally
9 relating to a standardized course numbering system in public schools.

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

17 **Article – Education**

18 **7–112.1.**

19 (A) **SUBJECT TO THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION, THE**
20 **DEPARTMENT MAY DEVELOP A STANDARDIZED COURSE NUMBERING SYSTEM TO**

1 FACILITATE THE COLLECTION OF DATA ON STUDENT PARTICIPATION IN
2 COURSES OFFERED BY THE PUBLIC SCHOOLS.

3 (B) THE COURSE NUMBERING SYSTEM SHALL BE AVAILABLE FOR
4 ADOPTION BY EACH COUNTY SCHOOL SYSTEM ON A VOLUNTARY BASIS.

5 (C) IF THE DEPARTMENT REQUIRES A DATA COLLECTION INVOLVING
6 COURSE NUMBERS, A COUNTY SCHOOL SYSTEM THAT HAS NOT ADOPTED THE
7 STATE STANDARDIZED COURSE NUMBERING SYSTEM SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE
8 FOR PROVIDING A TRANSLATION BETWEEN THE COUNTY SCHOOL SYSTEM'S
9 COURSE NUMBERS AND THOSE IN THE STATE STANDARDIZED COURSE
10 NUMBERING SYSTEM.

11 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
12 July 1, 2009.
