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## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Legislative Community Initiatives Loan of 2004 and Maryland Consolidated**  
3 **Capital Bond Loan of 2007 – Prince George’s County – Marlton Gazebo**

4 FOR the purpose of amending the Legislative Community Initiatives Loan of 2004 to  
5 allow the Marlton Gazebo Foundation to include certain prior expended funds in  
6 the required matching fund; amending the Maryland Consolidated Capital Bond  
7 Loan of 2007 to remove a requirement that the Marlton Gazebo Foundation  
8 grant a certain easement and to allow the Marlton Gazebo Foundation to  
9 include in kind contributions in the required matching fund; and generally  
10 relating to the Legislative Community Initiatives Loan of 2004 and the  
11 Maryland Consolidated Capital Bond Loan of 2007.

19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
20 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

21 **Chapter 204 of the Acts of 2003, as amended by Chapter 432 of the Acts of**  
22 **2004**

23 SECTION 13. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That:

24 (3) The cash proceeds of the sale of the bonds shall be paid to the Treasurer  
25 and first shall be applied to the payment of the expenses of issuing, selling, and

1 delivering the bonds, unless funds for this purpose are otherwise provided, and then  
2 shall be credited on the books of the Comptroller and expended, on approval by the  
3 Board of Public Works, for legislative community initiatives, including applicable  
4 architects' and engineers' fees, determined as follows:

5 (i) \$15,200,000 for the following projects initially approved by the  
6 Senate:

16 **Chapter 488 of the Acts of 2007**

17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
18 MARYLAND, That:

19 (3) ZA01 LOCAL HOUSE INITIATIVES

20	(BA)	Marlton Gazebo. Provide a grant equal to the lesser of (i)	
21		\$100,000 or (ii) the amount of the matching fund provided, to	
22		the Marlton Gazebo Foundation for the planning, design,	
23		construction, repair, reconstruction, and capital equipping of	
24		the Marlton Gazebo, located in Upper Marlboro[, subject to a	
25		requirement that the grantee grant and convey a historic	
26		easement to the Maryland Historical Trust]. Notwithstanding	
27		Section 1(5) of this Act, the matching fund may consist of <b>IN</b>	
28		<b>KIND CONTRIBUTIONS OR</b> funds expended prior to the	
29		effective date of this Act (Prince George's County) ..... 100,000	

30 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
31 June 1, 2009.
