BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 14 Article - Real Property 15 11–109.1. 16 A meeting of the board of directors may be held in closed session only for (a) 17 the following purposes: 18 **(1)** Discussion of matters pertaining to employees and personnel; 19 Protection of the privacy or reputation of individuals in matters not (2)20 related to the council of unit owners' business; 21 (3)Consultation with legal counsel;

1 **(4)** Consultation with staff personnel, consultants, attorneys, or other 2 persons in connection with pending or potential litigation; 3 **(5)** Investigative proceedings concerning possible or actual criminal 4 misconduct; OR 5 (6) Complying with a specific constitutional, statutory, or judicially 6 imposed requirement protecting particular proceedings or matters from public 7 disclosure[; or 8 (7)On an individually recorded affirmative vote of two-thirds of the board members present, for some other exceptional reason so compelling as to override 9 10 the general public policy in favor of open meetings]. 11 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 12 October 1, 2009.
