- FOR the purpose of requiring the Governor to proclaim the month of October to be
 Young Heroes Month; and generally relating to Young Heroes Month.

11 WHEREAS, Young heroes have played and continue to play a significant role in12 Maryland; and

WHEREAS, All Americans should learn about and recognize the achievements
 of young heroes, the important role that young heroes played throughout the history of

WHEREAS, The General Assembly believes that the month of October should
 be commemorated as Young Heroes Month in Maryland; now, therefore,

- 18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 19 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

2 (A) IN RECOGNITION OF THE SIGNIFICANT CONTRIBUTIONS THAT
 3 YOUNG HEROES HAVE MADE TO THE STATE, THE GOVERNOR SHALL PROCLAIM
 4 THE MONTH OF OCTOBER EACH YEAR AS YOUNG HEROES MONTH.

5 (B) THE PROCLAMATION SHALL URGE EDUCATIONAL AND CULTURAL 6 ORGANIZATIONS TO OBSERVE YOUNG HEROES MONTH PROPERLY WITH 7 APPROPRIATE PROGRAMS, CEREMONIES, AND ACTIVITIES.
