5 Review Committee; extending the termination date for a provision of law  
6 relating to certain reports regarding incidents of injury and certain  
7 recommendations and findings by the Mortality and Quality Review Committee;  
8 and generally relating to the Mortality and Quality Review Committee and  
9 reportable incidents of injury.

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
19 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

20 **Article – Health – General**

2 (a) The Committee shall consist of 18 members appointed by the Secretary,  
3 including the following:

4 (8) The Deputy Secretary of [Public Health] **BEHAVIORAL HEALTH**  
5 **AND DISABILITIES** or the Deputy Secretary’s designee;

7 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
8 July 1, 2006. ~~It shall remain effective for a period of 3 **6** years and 3 **6** months and, at~~  
9 ~~the end of September 30, 2009~~ **DECEMBER 31, 2012**, with no further action required  
10 by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and  
11 effect.†

12 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
13 October 1, 2009.
