12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article – Courts and Judicial Proceedings**

15 1–503.

16 (a) In each county in the first seven judicial circuits there shall be the
17 number of resident judges of the circuit court set forth below, including the judge or
18 judges provided for by the Constitution:

- 19 (1) Allegany 2
- 20 (2) Anne Arundel..... [11] 12
- 21 (3) Baltimore County [17] 18
- 22 (4) Calvert..... 2
