## Income Tax - Net Operating Loss Deductions - Loss from Criminal Fraud or Embezzlement

FOR the purpose of providing an exception for certain net operating losses to a certain provision requiring certain modifications to federal adjusted gross income to determine Maryland adjusted gross income without regard to a certain special net operating loss carryback period; providing for the application of this Act; making this Act an emergency measure; and generally relating to the Maryland income tax treatment of certain net operating losses.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That, notwithstanding any other provision of law, the modification to federal adjusted gross income required under § 10–210.1(b)(2) of the Tax – General Article, to determine Maryland adjusted gross income of an individual without regard to the special net operating loss carryback period provided under § 172(b)(1)(H) of the Internal Revenue Code, does not apply to any net operating loss covered under Internal Revenue Service Revenue Ruling 2009–9 and substantiated under Internal Revenue Service Revenue Procedure 2009–20.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be applicable to any taxable year to which § 172(b)(1)(H) of the Internal Revenue Code, as amended by the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (P.L. 111–5), applies.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health or safety, has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three–fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is enacted.
