<u>Further provided that no funds may be expended for an Executive Branch</u> <u>salary in excess of \$149,999 and that general funds of \$1,700,000 for Executive Branch</u> <u>salaries are reduced.</u>

<u>Further provided that three chef positions at Government House are deleted</u> and associated general funds of \$200,000 are reduced.

<u>Further provided that the remaining \$10,000,000 in special funds in the</u> <u>Department of Natural Resources, representing remaining funds from the Chesapeake</u> <u>and Atlantic Coastal Bays 2010 Trust Fund, are reduced.</u>

<u>Further provided that on or before July 1, 2010, the Governor shall develop a</u> <u>schedule to allocate a reduction of \$6,200,000 for electricity (Comptroller subobject</u> <u>0620) across Executive Branch agencies in the following amounts:</u>
