AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 1465

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike “Delegate Beitzel” and substitute “Delegates Beitzel, Hammen, Pendergrass, Bromwell, Costa, Donoghue, Elliott, Jenkins, Kach, Kipke, Krebs, Kullen, Montgomery, Morhaim, Nathan-Pulliam, Oaks, Pena-Melnyk, Reznik, Riley, Tarrant, and V. Turner”; and in line 6, after “States;” insert “requiring the Board of Public Works to adopt certain regulations”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, in line 14, after “IF” insert “:

**(I)**;

and in line 15, after “STATES” insert “:

**(II) THE ITEM OR A SIMILAR ITEM IS NOT MANUFACTURED OR AVAILABLE FOR PURCHASE IN THE UNITED STATES IN REASONABLY AVAILABLE QUANTITIES;**

**(III) THE PRICE OF THE ITEM OR A SIMILAR ITEM MANUFACTURED IN THE UNITED STATES EXCEEDS THE PRICE OF A SIMILAR, AVAILABLE ITEM THAT IS NOT MANUFACTURED IN THE UNITED STATES BY AN UNREASONABLE AMOUNT; OR**

**(IV) THE QUALITY OF THE ITEM OR A SIMILAR ITEM MANUFACTURED IN THE UNITED STATES IS SUBSTANTIALLY LESS THAN THE**

(Over)

QUALITY OF A COMPARABLY PRICED, SIMILAR, AND AVAILABLE ITEM THAT IS NOT MANUFACTURED IN THE UNITED STATES.

(3) THE BOARD SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS DEFINING THE FOLLOWING TERMS FOR THE PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION:

(I) “REASONABLY AVAILABLE”;

(II) “UNREASONABLE AMOUNT”; AND

(III) “SUBSTANTIALLY LESS”.
