1 AN ACT concerning

State Board of Examiners of Nursing Home Administrators – Sunset Extension and Program Evaluation

4 FOR the purpose of continuing the State Board of Examiners of Nursing Home $\mathbf{5}$ Administrators in accordance with the provisions of the Maryland Program 6 Evaluation Act (sunset law) by extending to a certain date the termination 7provisions relating to the statutory and regulatory authority of the Board; 8 requiring that an evaluation of the Board and the statutes and regulations that 9 relate to the Board be performed on or before a certain date; requiring the 10 Board to submit a certain report on or before a certain date; and generally relating to the State Board of Examiners of Nursing Home Administrators. 11

2 HOUSE BILL 137
SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
Article – Health Occupations
9-502.
Subject to the evaluation and reestablishment provisions of the Program Evaluation Act, this title and all rules and regulations adopted under this title shall terminate and be of no effect after July 1, [2013] 2017 .
Article – State Government
8-403.
(a) On or before December 15 of the 2nd year before the evaluation date of a governmental activity or unit, the Legislative Policy Committee, based on a preliminary evaluation, may waive as unnecessary the evaluation required under this

14(b)Except as otherwise provided in subsection (a) of this section, on or before 15the evaluation date for the following governmental activities or units, an evaluation shall be made of the following governmental activities or units and the statutes and 16

regulations that relate to the governmental activities or units: 17

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That on or before October 1, 202011, the State Board of Examiners of Nursing Home Administrators shall submit a 2122report to the Senate Finance Committee and the House Health and Government 23Operations Committee, in accordance with § 2–1246 of the State Government Article, 24on:

25(1)a plan to improve the timeliness and functioning of its disciplinary 26process, including the complaint investigation process;

27a jointly developed plan to improve communication between the (2)28Board and the Department of Aging's Long Term Care Ombudsman Program;

29(3)a review of trends in licensing, with a focus on new licenses issued, 30 the stability of renewal of licenses, and licensees on inactive status;

31 (4)implementation of an online renewal process;

32implementation of the planned database to track deficiency survey (5)33 reports;

1 (6) implementation of new and revised regulations proposed through 2 the Regulatory Review and Evaluation Process in 2009, including those relating to the 3 Administrator–In–Training program, the disciplinary process, and new causes for 4 disciplinary action; and

5 (7) the additional revenue generated from alterations to the fee 6 structure through proposed regulatory changes.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effectJuly 1, 2010.
