## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Motor Vehicles – Renewal of Drivers’ Licenses – Contractors for the Armed**  
3 **Forces of the United States**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring the Motor Vehicle Administration to renew the driver’s  
5 license of an individual who does not have a Maryland residence address if the  
6 individual provides certain documentation indicating that the individual resides  
7 outside the United States and is, or is the spouse or dependent of, a contractor  
8 who performs work for the armed forces of the United States and if the  
9 individual meets certain other requirements; and generally relating to the  
10 renewal of drivers’ licenses.

13 Section 16–115(j)  
14 Annotated Code of Maryland  
15 (2009 Replacement Volume and 2009 Supplement)

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 **Article – Transportation**

19 16–115.

20 **(J) THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL RENEW THE DRIVER’S LICENSE OF AN**  
21 **INDIVIDUAL WHO DOES NOT HAVE A MARYLAND RESIDENCE ADDRESS IF THE**  
22 **INDIVIDUAL:**

1                   **(1) PROVIDES DOCUMENTATION ACCEPTABLE TO THE**  
2 **ADMINISTRATION INDICATING THAT THE INDIVIDUAL RESIDES OUTSIDE THE**  
3 **UNITED STATES AND IS:**

4                   **(I) A CONTRACTOR WHO PERFORMS WORK FOR THE ARMED**  
5 **FORCES OF THE UNITED STATES; OR**

6                   **(II) A SPOUSE OR DEPENDENT OF A CONTRACTOR WHO**  
7 **PERFORMS WORK FOR THE ARMED FORCES OF THE UNITED STATES; AND**

8                   **(2) MEETS ALL OTHER REQUIREMENTS NOT RELATED TO**  
9 **RESIDENCE.**

10                   SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
11                   October 1, 2010.
