## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Criminal Procedure – Child Sexual Offenders – Monitoring with Global**  
3 **Positioning Satellite Tracking Technology**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring that on conviction for a certain sexual offense involving  
5 a minor victim, a person who has not previously been convicted of a certain  
6 sexual offense be monitored constantly with global positioning satellite tracking  
7 technology during any periods of probation and parole; requiring that on  
8 conviction for a certain sexual offense involving a minor victim, a person who  
9 has been convicted on a prior occasion not arising out of the same incident of a  
10 certain sexual offense be monitored constantly with global positioning satellite  
11 tracking technology for life and pay the costs of the monitoring; and generally  
12 relating to monitoring of child sexual offenders.

18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
19 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

22 **(A) ON CONVICTION OF A VIOLATION OF § 3–303, § 3–304, § 3–305, OR §**  
23 **3–306 OF THIS SUBTITLE INVOLVING A MINOR VICTIM, A PERSON WHO HAS NOT**  
24 **PREVIOUSLY BEEN CONVICTED OF A VIOLATION OF § 3–303, § 3–304, § 3–305,**  
25 **OR § 3–306 OF THIS SUBTITLE, OR A CRIME COMMITTED IN ANOTHER STATE OR**

1 IN A FEDERAL, MILITARY, OR NATIVE AMERICAN TRIBAL JURISDICTION THAT  
2 WOULD CONSTITUTE A VIOLATION OF § 3-303, § 3-304, § 3-305, OR § 3-306 OF  
3 THIS SUBTITLE IF COMMITTED IN THIS STATE, SHALL BE MONITORED  
4 CONSTANTLY WITH GLOBAL POSITIONING SATELLITE TRACKING TECHNOLOGY  
5 DURING ANY PERIODS OF PROBATION AND PAROLE.

6 (B) ON CONVICTION OF A VIOLATION OF § 3-303, § 3-304, § 3-305, OR §  
7 3-306 OF THIS SUBTITLE INVOLVING A MINOR VICTIM, A PERSON WHO HAS BEEN  
8 CONVICTED ON A PRIOR OCCASION NOT ARISING FROM THE SAME INCIDENT OF  
9 A VIOLATION OF § 3-303, § 3-304, § 3-305, OR § 3-306 OF THIS SUBTITLE, OR A  
10 CRIME COMMITTED IN ANOTHER STATE OR IN A FEDERAL, MILITARY, OR  
11 NATIVE AMERICAN TRIBAL JURISDICTION THAT WOULD CONSTITUTE A  
12 VIOLATION OF § 3-303, § 3-304, § 3-305, OR § 3-306 OF THIS SUBTITLE IF  
13 COMMITTED IN THIS STATE, SHALL:

14 (1) BE MONITORED CONSTANTLY WITH GLOBAL POSITIONING  
15 SATELLITE TRACKING TECHNOLOGY FOR LIFE; AND

16 (2) PAY THE COSTS OF THE MONITORING.

17 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
18 October 1, 2010.
