# AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 850

(First Reading File Bill)

## AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, strike in their entirety lines 2 and 3 and substitute "<u>Licensed Insurance Producers – Information on State Health Programs</u>"; strike beginning with "requiring" in line 4 down through "requiring" in line 10 and substitute "<u>authorizing</u>"; in line 12, strike "public health plans on a certain form and at a certain time" and substitute "<u>State health programs in accordance with regulations adopted by the Maryland Insurance Commissioner</u>"; and strike beginning with "requiring" in line 13 down through "plans" in line 16 and substitute "<u>and generally relating to licensed insurance producers and information on State health programs</u>".

On pages 1 and 2, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 17 on page 1 through line 3 on page 2, inclusive.

On page 2, strike in their entirety lines 9 through 13, inclusive.

### AMENDMENT NO. 2

On pages 2 through 4, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 17 on page 2 through line 4 on page 4, inclusive.

## AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 4, strike beginning with "IN" in line 6 down through "PRODUCER" in line 15 and substitute "IN ACCORDANCE WITH REGULATIONS ADOPTED BY THE COMMISSIONER, A LICENSED INSURANCE PRODUCER MAY PROVIDE TO A SMALL EMPLOYER INFORMATION ABOUT THE MARYLAND MEDICAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM AND THE MARYLAND CHILDREN'S HEALTH PROGRAM FOR THE SMALL EMPLOYER TO DISTRIBUTE TO ITS EMPLOYEES DURING THE ENROLLMENT PERIOD.

- (2) THE INFORMATION PROVIDED UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION SHALL BE RESTRICTED TO GENERAL INFORMATION ABOUT THE MARYLAND MEDICAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM AND THE MARYLAND CHILDREN'S HEALTH PROGRAM, INCLUDING:
  - (I) INCOME ELIGIBILITY THRESHOLDS; AND
  - (II) <u>APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS</u>".

## AMENDMENT NO. 4

On pages 4 and 5, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 16 on page 4 through line 12 on page 5, inclusive.
