(Over)

(A) <u>A DENTAL HYGIENIST MAY MONITOR A PATIENT TO WHOM NITROUS</u> OXIDE IS ADMINISTERED PROVIDED THE MONITORING OF THE PATIENT IS UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF A DENTIST WHO IS PHYSICALLY PRESENT ON THE PREMISES.

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(B) BEFORE A DENTAL HYGIENIST MAY MONITOR A PATIENT TO WHOM NITROUS OXIDE IS ADMINISTERED, THE DENTAL HYGIENIST SHALL SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETE THE FOLLOWING:

(1) ANY EDUCATIONAL REQUIREMENTS ESTABLISHED BY THE BOARD; AND

(2) <u>A WRITTEN AND CLINICAL EXAMINATION AS REQUIRED BY</u> THE BOARD.

(C) A DENTAL HYGIENIST SHALL COMPLETE THE EDUCATIONAL REQUIREMENTS ESTABLISHED BY THE BOARD UNDER SUBSECTION (B)(1) OF THIS SECTION THROUGH AN ACCREDITED DENTAL HYGIENE PROGRAM.";

and in line 22, after "2011." insert "<u>It shall remain effective for a period of 3 years and,</u> <u>at the end of September 30, 2014, with no further action required by the General</u> <u>Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.</u>".
