AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 1213, AS AMENDED
(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

In the Committee on Ways and Means Amendments (HB1213/385160/1), strike Amendment No. 3 in its entirety.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1 of the Committee on Ways and Means Amendments, in line 2 of Amendment No. 1, strike "Supplementary Appropriation"; strike beginning with "making" in line 4 down through "improvements:" in line 6 and substitute "requiring the Comptroller to distribute certain revenue from the sales and use tax on the sales of an alcoholic beverage to a special fund, to be used only for certain purposes:"; and in line 7, strike "and a supplementary appropriation".

On page 1 of the bill, in line 2, strike "-".

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 1 of the Committee on Ways and Means Amendments, in line 4 of Amendment No. 2, after "(G)" insert "(1)"; and in line 6, after "BEVERAGE." insert:

“(2) NOTWITHSTANDING § 2-1303 OF THIS ARTICLE, THE COMPTROLLER SHALL DISTRIBUTE THE REVENUE ATTRIBUTABLE TO A SALES AND USE TAX RATE IN EXCESS OF 6% ON THE SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES TO A SPECIAL FUND, TO BE USED ONLY AS FOLLOWS:

(1) 50% TO SUPPORT SERVICES TO INDIVIDUALS WHO ARE ON THE DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES ADMINISTRATION WAITING LIST AND

(Over)

ARE ELIGIBLE FOR, BUT NOT RECEIVING, SERVICES FROM THE
ADMINISTRATION; AND

(II) 50% TO SUPPORT COMMUNITY-BASED PROGRAMS FOR
THE TREATMENT AND PREVENTION OF MENTAL ILLNESSES IN CHILDREN AND
ADULTS, INCLUDING TREATMENT FOR THOSE WITH CO-OCCURRING SUBSTANCE
USE AND MENTAL HEALTH DISORDERS.”.
