AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 806  
(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 4, after “system;” insert “requiring an individual who registered to vote other than in person at certain locations with certain State or local government agencies to establish the individual’s identity by certain means when the individual appears at a polling place to vote for the first time after registering to vote;”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, after line 20, insert:

**“(C) AN INDIVIDUAL WHO REGISTERED TO VOTE OTHER THAN IN PERSON AT A LOCAL BOARD OFFICE OR THE STATE BOARD, AT A SITE ADMINISTERED BY A LOCAL BOARD, OR AT THE MOTOR VEHICLE ADMINISTRATION, WHO APPEARS AT THE INDIVIDUAL’S POLLING PLACE TO VOTE FOR THE FIRST TIME AFTER REGISTERING TO VOTE SHALL ESTABLISH THE INDIVIDUAL’S IDENTITY BY PRESENTING TO AN ELECTION JUDGE ONE OF THE FOLLOWING:**

**(1) A CURRENT AND VALID GOVERNMENT-ISSUED PHOTO IDENTIFICATION CARD;**

**(2) A CURRENT W-2 FORM;**

**(3) A CURRENT SSA-1099 FORM;**

**(4) A CURRENT NON-SSA-1099 FORM;**

**(5) A CURRENT PAY STUB WITH THE VOTER'S NAME AND SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER ON IT; OR**

**(6) A COPY OF A CURRENT UTILITY BILL, BANK STATEMENT, GOVERNMENT CHECK, PAY CHECK, OR GOVERNMENT DOCUMENT THAT SHOWS THE NAME AND ADDRESS OF THE VOTER."**
