<u>AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 487</u> (First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 2, strike "Janet L. Hoffman Loan Assistance Repayment" and substitute "<u>Walter Sondheim Jr. Public Service Summer Internship Scholarship</u>"; strike beginning with "attend" in line 3 down through "and" in line 4; in lines 4 and 5, strike "with the State or local governments" and substitute "<u>that assist in providing certain legal services</u>"; in lines 5 and 6, strike "Janet L. Hoffman Loan Assistance Repayment" and substitute "<u>Walter Sondheim Jr. Public Service Summer Internship Scholarship</u>"; strike beginning with "prohibiting" in line 6 down through "change;" in line 9; in line 10, strike "Janet L. Hoffman Loan Assistance Repayment" and substitute "<u>Walter Sondheim Jr. Public Service Repayment</u>" and substitute "<u>Walter Sondheim Jr. Public Service Summer Internship Scholarship</u>"; and in line 14, strike "18-1501 and 18-1502" and substitute "<u>18-1702</u>".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, after line 19, insert:

"<u>18–1702.</u>

(a) <u>There is a scholarship program known as the Walter Sondheim Jr. Public</u> Service Summer Internship Scholarship Program in the State.

(b) <u>The purpose of the Program is to assist college and graduate students to</u> <u>explore public service career opportunities through summer internships.</u>

(c) <u>The Shriver Center shall administer the Program.</u>

(d) On or before January 1 of each year, an institution of higher education in the State may nominate eligible students to participate in the Program.

(Over)

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(e) <u>Priority for participation in the Program shall be given to an eligible</u> <u>student who:</u>

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- (1) Is a resident of the State;
- (2) Has demonstrated an interest in a career in public service; and
- (3) Assists in providing:
 - (i) <u>Legal services</u>:

2. IN A PUBLIC SERVICE POSITION;

(ii) Social work services to low-income residents in the State;

(iii) Nursing services in nursing shortage areas in the State as defined in § 18–802 of this title; or

(iv) Other services in the public or nonprofit sectors in which there is a shortage of qualified practitioners to low-income or underserved residents or areas of the State.

(f) (1) Subject to paragraph (3) of this subsection, on or before May 1 of each year, the Shriver Center shall award scholarships to eligible students who have agreed to serve in a public service summer internship.

(2) The Shriver Center shall award no more than:

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- (i) 75 scholarships for the summer of 2008; and
- (ii) <u>100 scholarships for the summer of 2009.</u>

(3) Funds for the scholarships awarded under this subtitle shall be as provided in the State budget.

(g) <u>Subject to the availability of funds, the scholarship award under the</u> <u>Program shall be \$3,000.</u>

(h) <u>The Shriver Center shall serve as a clearinghouse for public and</u> nonprofit entities who wish to hire public service summer interns participating in the <u>Program.</u>".

AMENDMENT NO. 3
