14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – State Government

17 **2–203.**

AFTER A DECENNIAL CENSUS, ON ESTABLISHMENT BY THE GOVERNOR OF AN ADVISORY COMMITTEE TO FORMULATE A LEGISLATIVE DISTRICTING PLAN FOR THE ELECTION OF MEMBERS OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, THE ADVISORY COMMITTEE SHALL, TO THE GREATEST EXTENT PRACTICABLE, DRAW THE LINES FOR THE DISTRICTS SO THAT EACH COUNTY IN THE STATE HAS AT LEAST ONE RESIDENT DELEGATE.
