A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Video Lottery Operation Licenses – Information on Payouts**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring that regulations adopted by the State Lottery
4 Commission include provisions that require certain payouts above certain
5 amounts be reported to the Department of Human Resources' Child Support
6 Enforcement Administration for certain purposes; and generally relating to
7 video lottery terminal payouts and the holding of a video lottery operation
8 license.

19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
20 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

21 **Article – State Government**

22 9–1A–24.

23 (a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, the Commission shall
24 ensure that a video lottery operation licensee complies with the requirements of this
25 section as a condition of holding the video lottery operation license.

1 (f) In order to protect the public interest, the regulations shall include
2 provisions that:

3 (1) limit the number and location of and maximum withdrawal
4 amounts from automated teller machines;

5 (2) require payouts above an amount adopted by the Commission to be
6 made by check;

7 **(3) REQUIRE THAT PAYOUTS ABOVE AN AMOUNT ADOPTED BY**
8 **THE COMMISSION MADE BY CHECK BE REPORTED TO THE DEPARTMENT OF**
9 **HUMAN RESOURCES' CHILD SUPPORT ENFORCEMENT ADMINISTRATION FOR**
10 **THE PURPOSE OF ENFORCING CHILD SUPPORT ORDERS ISSUED IN ACCORDANCE**
11 **WITH THE APPLICABLE PROVISIONS OF THE FAMILY LAW ARTICLE;**

12 **[(3)] (4)** require conspicuous disclosures related to the payout of
13 video lottery terminals;

14 **[(4)] (5)** limit the dollar amount that video lottery terminals will
15 accept;

16 **[(5)] (6)** prohibit the use of specified negotiable instruments at video
17 lottery facilities and the use of credit cards, debit cards, and similar devices in video
18 lottery terminals;

19 **[(6)] (7)** provide consumers with a record of video lottery terminal
20 spending levels if marketing measures are utilized that track consumer spending at
21 video lottery facilities;

22 **[(7)] (8)** prohibit consumers from cashing paychecks at video lottery
23 facilities; and

24 **[(8)] (9)** prohibit video lottery operation licensees from engaging in or
25 contracting with another to engage in predatory marketing practices.

26 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
27 October 1, 2011.
