1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Video Lottery Operation Licenses – Information on Payouts**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring that regulations adopted by the State Lottery
4 Commission include provisions that require certain payouts above certain
5 amounts be reported to the State Lottery Agency in a report that contains
6 certain information; requiring that the State Lottery Agency modify the report
7 in a certain manner and forward the modified report to the Department of
8 Human Resources' Child Support Enforcement Administration for certain
9 purposes; and generally relating to video lottery terminal payouts and the
10 holding of a video lottery operation license.

2 spending levels if marketing measures are utilized that track consumer spending at
3 video lottery facilities;

5 facilities; and

6 ~~[(8)] (9)~~ prohibit video lottery operation licensees from engaging in or
7 contracting with another to engage in predatory marketing practices.

8 **(G) (1) ON RECEIPT OF THE REPORT REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION**
9 **(F)(3) OF THIS SECTION, THE STATE LOTTERY AGENCY SHALL MODIFY THE**
10 **REPORT TO INCLUDE ONLY THE NAMES OF INDIVIDUALS WHO HAVE BEEN**
11 **CERTIFIED TO THE STATE LOTTERY AGENCY BY THE CHILD SUPPORT**
12 **ENFORCEMENT ADMINISTRATION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN**
13 **RESOURCES AS OBLIGORS WHO ARE IN ARREARS OF THEIR CHILD SUPPORT**
14 **ORDERS.**

15 **(2) THE STATE LOTTERY AGENCY SHALL FORWARD THE**
16 **MODIFIED REPORT TO THE CHILD SUPPORT ENFORCEMENT ADMINISTRATION**
17 **OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN RESOURCES FOR THE PURPOSE OF**
18 **ENFORCING CHILD SUPPORT ORDERS ISSUED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE**
19 **APPLICABLE PROVISIONS OF THE FAMILY LAW ARTICLE.**

20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
21 October 1, 2011.
