A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **State Board of Podiatric Medical Examiners – Sunset Extension and Program**
3 **Evaluation**

4 FOR the purpose of continuing the State Board of Podiatric Medical Examiners in
5 accordance with the provisions of the Maryland Program Evaluation Act (sunset
6 law) by extending to a certain date the termination provisions relating to the
7 statutory and regulatory authority of the Board; requiring that an evaluation of
8 the Board and the statutes and regulations that relate to the Board be
9 performed on or before a certain date; and generally relating to the State Board
10 of Podiatric Medical Examiners.

26 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
27 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

3 Subject to the evaluation and reestablishment provisions of the Program
4 Evaluation Act, this title and all rules and regulations adopted under this title shall
5 terminate and be of no effect after July 1, ~~2012~~ **2022**.

8 (a) On or before December 15 of the 2nd year before the evaluation date of a
9 governmental activity or unit, the Legislative Policy Committee, based on a
10 preliminary evaluation, may waive as unnecessary the evaluation required under this
11 section.

12 (b) Except as otherwise provided in subsection (a) of this section, on or before
13 the evaluation date for the following governmental activities or units, an evaluation
14 shall be made of the following governmental activities or units and the statutes and
15 regulations that relate to the governmental activities or units:

16 (52) Podiatric Medical Examiners, State Board of (§ 16–201 of the
17 Health Occupations Article: July 1, ~~2011~~ **2021**);

18 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
19 July 1, 2011.
