(c) 3 Except as otherwise provided in this subtitle, an applicant shall be a high 4 school graduate or have completed equivalent education and have completed 5 satisfactorily: 6 An electrology education program, taught by a licensed electrology 7 instructor, that includes at least 600 hours of instruction, and has been approved by 8 the Board: or 9 An electrology education program in any other state that the Board determines is substantially equivalent to that required by item (1) of this subsection. 10 11 (e) (1) Except as otherwise provided in this subtitle, each applicant shall 12 pass: 13 [A national certification] AN examination [developed by the American Electrology Association or its successor, as approved by the Board; and 14 A clinical examination [administered] APPROVED by the 15 (ii) 16 Board. 17 (2)Applicants are responsible for scheduling the [national and 18 clinical examinations REQUIRED UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION. 19 In addition to the other requirements of this section, an applicant for an (f) 20 electrology instructor license shall: 21Be a licensed electrologist; (1) 22 Have practiced electrology actively for at least 5 years immediately (2)23 before the application; 24(3)Pass an examination approved by the Board; and 25 Meet any other requirements set forth in regulations adopted by 26 the Board under § 8–6B–03 of this subtitle. 8-6B-14. 27 28 A license expires on a date set by the Board, unless the license is renewed 29 for an additional term as provided in this section.
 - (b) (1) [A] ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 31, 2012, A license may not be renewed for a term longer than 1 year.

- 1 (2) BEGINNING ON JANUARY 1, 2013, A LICENSE MAY NOT BE 2 RENEWED FOR A TERM LONGER THAN 2 YEARS.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2011.
