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Charlotte Hall Veterans Home – Gifts and Grants – Authority to Accept and
 Spend

FOR the purpose of authorizing the Charlotte Hall Veterans Home to accept certain
gifts and grants for use at the Home; providing for certain uses and
administration of the gifts and grants accepted for use at the Home; requiring
the Director of the Veterans Home Program and the Secretary of Veterans
Affairs to report each year on the status of the gifts and grants accepted for use
at the Home; and generally relating to the authority of the Charlotte Hall
Veterans Home to accept and spend certain gifts and grants.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF $\mathbf{2}$ MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 3 **Article – State Government** 4 9-912.1. SUBJECT TO TITLE 7 OF THE STATE FINANCE AND PROCUREMENT $\mathbf{5}$ (A) 6 ARTICLE, TO CARRY OUT THE PURPOSES OR GOALS OF THE DEPARTMENT, THE 7 **CHARLOTTE HALL VETERANS HOME MAY:** 8 (1) ACCEPT A GIFT OR GRANT FOR USE AT THE CHARLOTTE HALL 9 **VETERANS HOME; AND** 10 (2) UNLESS THE TERMS OF A GIFT OR GRANT REQUIRE OTHERWISE, AND SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE SECRETARY, SPEND THE 11 12 PRINCIPAL AND INCOME OF THE GIFT OR GRANT FOR USE AT THE CHARLOTTE 13 HALL VETERANS HOME. GIFTS AND GRANTS THAT THE CHARLOTTE HALL VETERANS HOME 14 **(B)** 15ACCEPTS UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION FOR USE AT THE HOME: 16 (1) SHALL BE ADMINISTERED BY THE DIRECTOR OF THE 17 **VETERANS HOME PROGRAM; AND** 18 ARE NOT SUBJECT TO REVERSION UNDER § 7-302 OF THE (2) STATE FINANCE AND PROCUREMENT ARTICLE. 19 20(C) (1) ON OR BEFORE JULY 31 OF EACH YEAR, THE DIRECTOR OF THE VETERANS HOME PROGRAM SHALL SUBMIT A REPORT TO THE SECRETARY 2122ON THE STATUS OF THE GIFTS AND GRANTS ACCEPTED FOR USE AT THE 23CHARLOTTE HALL VETERANS HOME. 24(2) ON OR BEFORE AUGUST 31 OF EACH YEAR, THE SECRETARY 25SHALL SUBMIT A REPORT TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 262-1246 OF THIS ARTICLE, ON THE STATUS OF THE GIFTS AND GRANTS 27ACCEPTED FOR USE AT THE CHARLOTTE HALL VETERANS HOME. 28THE REPORTS REQUIRED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION SHALL (3) INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION ON THE GIFTS AND GRANTS ACCEPTED 29FOR USE AT THE CHARLOTTE HALL VETERANS HOME DURING THE PREVIOUS 30 31FISCAL YEAR:

(I) THE GROSS AMOUNT OF THE GIFTS AND GRANTS;

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1(II) THE COSTS OF ADMINISTRATION OF THE GIFTS AND2GRANTS; AND

3(III) A DETAILED ACCOUNTING OF THE USE OF THE GIFTS4AND GRANTS.

5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 6 October 1, 2011.
