- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

 18 (a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, a motor carrier permit
 19 is required for a passenger motor vehicle used in the transportation of persons for hire.
- 20 (b) A motor carrier permit is not required for:
- 21 (1) a motor vehicle used exclusively for the transportation of pupils to 22 and from public or private schools;
