## A BILL ENTITLED

#### 1 AN ACT concerning

### 2 Alcoholic Beverages – Anne Arundel County – Entertainment Facility

- 3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Board of License Commissioners of Anne Arundel 4 County to issue a certain entertainment facility license to certain persons for  $\mathbf{5}$ certain purposes; providing for the scope of the entertainment facility license; 6 authorizing the Board to issue a certain entertainment concessionaire license to 7 certain persons for certain purposes; providing for the scope of the 8 entertainment concessionaire license; providing that beer, wine, and liquor sold 9 under an entertainment facility license or an entertainment concessionaire 10 license may be consumed anywhere in the entertainment facility; specifying that the licenses authorize the playing of music and dancing; providing that 11 12certain provisions relating to a special Sunday license do not apply to an 13entertainment facility license or an entertainment concessionaire license; 14 providing for the annual fees and payment date for the licenses; providing for 15the application to certain persons of certain penalties and sanctions for 16 violations occurring on certain premises; defining certain terms; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages and entertainment facilities in Anne Arundel 17 18 County.

24 25 26 27 28	(II) THE BOARD MAY ISSUE AN ENTERTAINMENT FACILITY LICENSE FOR AN ENTERTAINMENT FACILITY THAT CONTAINS ONE OR MORE RESTAURANTS, BARS, LOUNGES, OR OTHER ESTABLISHMENTS THAT ARE ASSOCIATED WITH AND SUPPORT THE OPERATION OF THE ENTERTAINMENT FACILITY.
29 30 31 32	(III) THE ENTERTAINMENT FACILITY LICENSE MAY BE ISSUED TO AN INDIVIDUAL OR ENTITY THAT OWNS AN ENTERTAINMENT FACILITY AND HOLDS A LICENSE UNDER TITLE 9, SUBTITLE 1A OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE.

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1 (IV) AN APPLICANT FOR AN ENTERTAINMENT FACILITY  $\mathbf{2}$ LICENSE NEED NOT MEET ANY LOCATION, VOTING, **OR RESIDENCY** 3 **REQUIREMENTS.** 4 **(**V**)** AN ENTERTAINMENT FACILITY LICENSE AUTHORIZES THE HOLDER TO SELL BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR ON ANY PREMISES OF THE  $\mathbf{5}$ ENTERTAINMENT FACILITY THAT IS NOT COVERED BY AN ENTERTAINMENT 6 7LICENSE FOR CONSUMPTION **ANYWHERE** CONCESSIONAIRE IN THE 8 ENTERTAINMENT FACILITY. 9 (3) **(I)** THERE IS AN ENTERTAINMENT CONCESSIONAIRE 10 LICENSE. 11 **(II)** THE BOARD MAY ISSUE AN **ENTERTAINMENT** 12CONCESSIONAIRE LICENSE TO A CONCESSIONAIRE AT AN ENTERTAINMENT 13 FACILITY. 14(III) THE ENTERTAINMENT CONCESSIONAIRE LICENSE 15AUTHORIZES THE HOLDER TO SELL BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR ON THE PREMISES OF FOR CONSUMPTION 16 CONCESSIONAIRE ANYWHERE THE IN THE 17ENTERTAINMENT FACILITY. 18 (4) **(I)** THE ANNUAL FEE FOR AN ENTERTAINMENT FACILITY 19LICENSE IS \$7,500. 20**(II)** THE ANNUAL FEE FOR AN **ENTERTAINMENT CONCESSIONAIRE LICENSE IS \$5,000.** 2122(III) THE ANNUAL LICENSE FEES SHALL BE PAID ON MAY 1 23TO THE BOARD. 24(5) BEER, WINE, AND LIQUOR THAT IS PURCHASED ANYWHERE IN 25AN ENTERTAINMENT FACILITY MAY BE TRANSPORTED AND CONSUMED 26ANYWHERE IN THE ENTERTAINMENT FACILITY. 27FACILITY (6) AN ENTERTAINMENT LICENSE AND AN 28ENTERTAINMENT CONCESSIONAIRE LICENSE AUTHORIZE THE PLAYING OF 29MUSIC AND DANCING IN THEIR RESPECTIVE LICENSED PREMISES. 30 SUBSECTION (D) OF THIS SECTION, RELATING TO SPECIAL (7) SUNDAY LICENSES, DOES NOT APPLY TO A LICENSE ISSUED UNDER THIS 3132 SUBSECTION.

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1(8) ANENTERTAINMENTFACILITYLICENSEORAN2ENTERTAINMENT CONCESSIONAIRE LICENSE MAY NOT BE COUNTED AS A CLASS3B OR CLASS H LICENSE FOR PURPOSES OF § 9–102(H–1) OF THIS ARTICLE.

4 (9) THE LICENSES AND HOLDERS ARE SUBJECT TO ALL LAWS AND
5 REGULATIONS APPLICABLE TO THE SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES NOT
6 INCONSISTENT WITH THIS SUBSECTION.

7 (10) ANY PENALTY OR OTHER SANCTION THAT IS IMPOSED FOR A 8 VIOLATION OF A REGULATION OF THE BOARD ON THE LICENSED PREMISES OF 9 THE HOLDER OF AN ENTERTAINMENT CONCESSIONAIRE LICENSE SHALL APPLY 10 TO THE CONCESSIONAIRE THAT THE BOARD DETERMINES TO BE RESPONSIBLE 11 FOR THE VIOLATION.

(h) The provisions of subsection (a) of this section do not apply in Anne
 Arundel County to licenses issued under this article for premises operated as resort
 complexes OR ENTERTAINMENT FACILITIES, INCLUDING ENTERTAINMENT
 CONCESSIONS.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effectJune 1, 2011.
