- 18 (b) (1) "Correctional officer" has the meaning stated in § 8–201 of this 19 article.
- 20 (2) "CORRECTIONAL OFFICER" DOES NOT INCLUDE AN OFFICER 21 WHO IS IN PROBATIONARY STATUS ON INITIAL ENTRY INTO THE CORRECTIONAL 22 AGENCY EXCEPT IF AN ALLEGATION OF BRUTALITY IN THE EXECUTION OF THE 23 OFFICER'S DUTIES IS MADE AGAINST THE OFFICER.
