A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Maryland–National Capital Park and Planning Commission – Prince**
3 **George's County – Capital Improvements Program Submission**

4 **MC/PG 111–11**

5 FOR the purpose of altering the date before which the Maryland–National Capital
6 Park and Planning Commission is required to prepare and submit a 6–year
7 capital improvements program to the county governing body of Prince George's
8 County; and generally relating to the submission of a 6–year capital
9 improvements program to the county governing body of Prince George's County
10 by the Maryland–National Capital Park and Planning Commission.

11 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,
12 Article 28 – Maryland–National Capital Park and Planning Commission
13 Section 2–118(b)(1)
14 Annotated Code of Maryland
15 (2010 Replacement Volume)

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 **Article 28 – Maryland–National Capital Park and Planning Commission**
19 2–118.

20 (b) (1) (i) The Commission shall prepare and submit a six–year capital
21 improvements program:

22 1. Before [November 1] **JANUARY 15** of each calendar
23 year to the county governing body of Prince George's County; and

1 2. Before November 1 of each odd-numbered calendar
2 year to the County Executive and County Council of Montgomery County.

3 (ii) The capital improvements program shall include a
4 statement of the objectives of the capital programs and relationship of these programs
5 to the county's adopted long range development plans; shall recommend capital
6 projects and a construction schedule; and shall provide an estimate of cost and a
7 statement of all funding sources. The capital improvements program shall include all
8 programmed parkland acquisition, all major parkland improvement, development and
9 major acquisition of equipment.

10 (iii) In Montgomery County, the County Executive shall submit
11 recommendations with respect to the Commission's proposed program (including any
12 suggested amendments, revisions or modifications) to the County Council as an
13 integral part of the comprehensive six-year capital improvements program required
14 by the charter for Montgomery County in each even-numbered calendar year.

15 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
16 October 1, 2011.
