## 1 AN ACT concerning

# Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission – Transfer of Single–Family Residential Real Property – Payment of Outstanding Charges and Costs

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#### MC/PG 105-11

5 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person from transferring the title of certain 6 single-family residential real property until a certain outstanding bill for water 7 or sewer usage charges and certain other charges and costs are paid to the 8 Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission; and generally relating to the 9 prohibition against transferring the title of certain real property in the 10 Washington Suburban Sanitary District until certain charges and costs are 11 paid.

2 (B) A PERSON MAY NOT TRANSFER THE TITLE OF ANY SINGLE-FAMILY 3 RESIDENTIAL REAL PROPERTY UNTIL ANY OUTSTANDING BILL FOR WATER OR 4 SEWER USAGE CHARGES, ANY LATE PAYMENT PENALTY CHARGES AUTHORIZED 5 BY LAW, AND ANY COSTS INCURRED IN SHUTTING OFF AND RESTORING THE 6 WATER SUPPLY ARE PAID TO THE COMMISSION.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
October 1, 2011.
