### 1 AN ACT concerning

# Harford County - Alcoholic Beverages - Continuing Care Facility for Aged Beer, Wine and Liquor License

#### 4 FOR the purpose of establishing a Class CCFA (continuing care facility for the aged) $\mathbf{5}$ beer, wine and liquor license in Harford County; specifying that the Liquor 6 Control Board may issue a Class CCFA license to certain organizations that 7provide certain care, are licensed as a certain institution, are certified by a 8 certain department, are exempt from certain taxes, and are located in Harford 9 County: authorizing a Class CCFA license holder to sell alcoholic beverages for 10 consumption on the licensed premises under certain circumstances; providing that certain prohibitions do not apply to this Act; and generally relating to beer, 11 12wine and liquor licenses in Harford County.
