Green Technology, Life Science, and Health Information Technology Loan Assistance Repayment Program

FOR the purpose of establishing the Green Technology, Life Science, and Health 4 5 Information Technology Loan Assistance Repayment Program; requiring the 6 Office of Student Financial Assistance to assist in the repayment of any federal 7 or State higher education loan owed by a resident of the State who meets 8 certain requirements; specifying that certain loan assistance may only be used 9 to repay certain higher education loans; specifying the amount of assistance that may be awarded; specifying that an individual awarded assistance may 10 only receive assistance for a certain number of years; specifying that the 11 12 assistance awarded to an individual, when combined with certain other 13 assistance, may not exceed a certain amount; requiring the Office to adopt certain regulations; requiring that funds for the Program be provided on an 14 15 annual basis in the State budget; requiring the Office to submit a certain report 16 on or before a certain date each year to the Governor and certain committees of the General Assembly; defining certain terms; and generally relating to the 17 18 Green Technology, Life Science, and Health Information Technology Loan 19 Assistance Repayment Program.
