A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning 2 Frederick County - Municipal Corporations - Building Excise Tax 3 FOR the purpose of authorizing a municipal corporation in Frederick County to retain the revenue from a building excise tax imposed by Frederick County in the 4 5 municipal corporation; requiring the county to remit the building excise tax for 6 a building located in a municipal corporation to the municipal corporation; and 7 generally relating to the building excise tax in Frederick County. 8 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, 9 The Public Local Laws of Frederick County Section 2–7–131(E) 10 Article 11 - Public Local Laws of Maryland 11 12 (2004 Edition and August 2010 Supplement, as amended) 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 14 15 **Article 11 – Frederick County** 16 2-7-131.17 (E) **(1)** [A] SUBJECT TO PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, A municipal corporation shall assist the county commissioners in the collection of the 18 19 building excise tax within the municipal corporation by: 20 [(1)] (I) Collecting and remitting the tax to the county; or 21[(2)] (II) Requiring the tax to be paid to the county commissioners in 22 accordance with a county ordinance.

- 1 (2) A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION THAT COLLECTS THE BUILDING 2 EXCISE TAX MAY RETAIN THE REVENUE FROM THE TAX IMPOSED IN THE 3 MUNICIPAL CORPORATION.
- 4 (3) IF THE COUNTY COLLECTS THE BUILDING EXCISE TAX FOR A BUILDING IN A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION, THE COUNTY SHALL REMIT THE REVENUE FROM THE TAX TO THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 8 July 1, 2011.
