# Montgomery County - Solicitation of Money or Donations from Occupants of Vehicles - Adoption of a Permit Program

### MC 20-11

 $\mathbf{5}$ FOR the purpose of authorizing the Montgomery County Council to enact a local law 6 to require a person to obtain a certain permit before standing in a median 7 divider or on a sidewalk adjacent to a roadway to solicit money or donations of 8 any kind from the occupant of a vehicle; prohibiting a person from standing, or 9 causing, encouraging, allowing, or petitioning a person to stand in a roadway, median divider, or intersection, or on a sidewalk adjacent to a roadway, to 10 solicit money or donations from the occupant of a vehicle, if a certain permit is 11 12required under a local law enacted under this Act and the permit has not been 13 obtained in accordance with the local law; prohibiting a local law enacted under 14this Act from authorizing a permit to be issued to a minor for certain purposes; and generally relating to the solicitation of money from occupants of vehicles in 1516 Montgomery County.

#### (1) THIS SUBSECTION APPLIES ONLY IN MONTGOMERY COUNTY.

 $\mathbf{2}$ [In Montgomery County, a] A child under the age of **[**(1)**] (2) (I)** 3 18 years may not stand in a roadway, median divider, or intersection to solicit money or donations of any kind from the occupant of a vehicle. 4

This [subsection] PARAGRAPH shall be enforced by the  $\mathbf{5}$ [(2)] **(II)** issuance of a warning that informs the offender of the requirements of this 6 7[subsection] PARAGRAPH.

8 (3) **(I)** THE MONTGOMERY COUNTY COUNCIL MAY ENACT A 9 LOCAL LAW TO REQUIRE A PERSON TO OBTAIN A PERMIT BEFORE THE PERSON 10 MAY STAND IN A MEDIAN DIVIDER OR ON A SIDEWALK ADJACENT TO A ROADWAY 11 TO SOLICIT MONEY OR DONATIONS OF ANY KIND FROM THE OCCUPANT OF A 12VEHICLE.

13IF A PERMIT IS REQUIRED UNDER A LOCAL LAW **(II)** 14ENACTED UNDER SUBPARAGRAPH (I) OF THIS PARAGRAPH, A PERSON WHO HAS NOT OBTAINED A PERMIT IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE LOCAL LAW MAY NOT: 15

16 1. STAND IN A ROADWAY, MEDIAN DIVIDER, OR INTERSECTION, OR ON A SIDEWALK ADJACENT TO A ROADWAY, TO SOLICIT 17MONEY OR DONATIONS OF ANY KIND FROM THE OCCUPANT OF A VEHICLE; OR 18

2. 19CAUSE, ENCOURAGE, ALLOW, OR PETITION A 20PERSON TO STAND IN A ROADWAY, MEDIAN DIVIDER, OR INTERSECTION, OR ON A SIDEWALK ADJACENT TO A ROADWAY, TO SOLICIT MONEY OR DONATIONS OF 2122ANY KIND FROM THE OCCUPANT OF A VEHICLE.

23(III) A LOCAL LAW ENACTED UNDER THIS SECTION MAY NOT 24AUTHORIZE A PERMIT TO BE ISSUED TO A MINOR FOR THE PURPOSE OF STANDING IN A MEDIAN DIVIDER TO SOLICIT MONEY OR DONATIONS OF ANY 2526KIND FROM THE OCCUPANT OF A VEHICLE.

27SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 28October 1. 2011.
