A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Electric Industry – Local Aggregation**

3 FOR the purpose of repealing the prohibition of a county or municipal corporation
4 from acting as an aggregator unless the Public Service Commission makes a
5 certain determination; and generally relating to the ability of a county or
6 municipal corporation to act as an aggregator of electricity.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article – Public Utilities**

15 7–510.

16 [(f) A county or municipal corporation may not act as an aggregator unless
17 the Commission determines there is not sufficient competition within the boundaries
18 of the county or municipal corporation.]

19 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
20 July 1, 2011.
