1 AN ACT concerning

Baltimore County – Miscellaneous Business Licenses – Fees

- 3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the County Executive and County Council of 4 Baltimore County to establish certain license fees that applicants are required $\mathbf{5}$ to pay for acting as a cigarette retailer, for selling cigarettes at retail, for 6 keeping a billiard table for commercial use, for doing certain construction 7 business, for keeping a garage where motor vehicles are stored for a fee, for 8 doing the business of cleaning or laundering, for doing business as a plumber or 9 gas fitter, for operating a restaurant, for doing business as a trader, and for 10 operating a chain store; and generally relating to business license fees in Baltimore County. 11
