Public Health - Food Product Labeling - Genetically Engineered Ingredients

- 3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a food product that contains or consists of ingredients of which more than a certain percentage are genetically engineered ingredients 4 5 from being sold in the State under certain circumstances; requiring the labeling 6 for a certain food product to include a certain statement; authorizing the 7 Secretary of Health and Mental Hygiene, in addition to certain other penalties, to seize or condemn any food product that is sold in violation of this Act; 8 9 defining a certain term; and generally relating to the labeling of food products containing genetically engineered ingredients. 10

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 18 Article Health General
- 19 **21–330.1.**
- 20 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "GENETICALLY ENGINEERED INGREDIENT"
 21 MEANS AN INGREDIENT THAT CONTAINS FOREIGN GENES THAT HAVE BEEN
 22 ARTIFICIALLY INSERTED INTO THE GENETIC CODE OF THE INGREDIENT.
- 23 (B) UNLESS THE PACKAGING OF A FOOD PRODUCT IS CLEARLY AND 24 CONSPICUOUSLY LABELED IN ACCORDANCE WITH SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS



- SECTION, NO FOOD PRODUCT THAT CONTAINS OR CONSISTS OF INGREDIENTS OF WHICH MORE THAN 1% ARE GENETICALLY ENGINEERED INGREDIENTS MAY
- 3 BE SOLD IN THE STATE.
- 4 (C) LABELING FOR A FOOD PRODUCT THAT CONTAINS OR CONSISTS OF INGREDIENTS OF WHICH MORE THAN 1% ARE GENETICALLY ENGINEERED INGREDIENTS SHALL INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING STATEMENT:
- 7 "THIS PRODUCT CONTAINS GENETICALLY ENGINEERED INGREDIENTS.".
- 8 (D) IN ADDITION TO THE PENALTIES PROVIDED IN § 21–1214 OF THIS 9 TITLE, THE SECRETARY MAY SEIZE OR CONDEMN ANY FOOD PRODUCT SOLD IN 10 VIOLATION OF THIS SECTION.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2011.
