# 2 Public Service Commission – Public Service Company – Definition

FOR the purpose of clarifying that certain utility services provided by a campground to campers incident to the campground's primary business of operating and maintaining the campground are not included in the definition of a "public service company" under a certain provision of law; and generally relating to the definition of a public service company.

3 (x) (1) "Public service company" means a common carrier company, 4 electric company, gas company, sewage disposal company, telegraph company, 5 telephone company, water company, or any combination of public service companies.

6 (2) "PUBLIC SERVICE COMPANY" DOES NOT INCLUDE A 7 CAMPGROUND THAT PROVIDES WATER, ELECTRIC, GAS, SEWAGE, OR 8 TELEPHONE SERVICE TO CAMPERS INCIDENT TO THE CAMPGROUND'S PRIMARY 9 BUSINESS OF OPERATING AND MAINTAINING THE CAMPGROUND.
