- 17 (a) A person may not distribute Salvia divinorum to an individual under the 18 age of 21 years.
- 19 (b) In a prosecution for a violation of this section, it is a defense that the 20 defendant examined the purchaser's or recipient's driver's license or other valid 21 identification issued by an employer, a government unit, or an institution of higher 22 education that positively identified the purchaser or recipient as at least 21 years of 23 age.



HOUSE BILL 1327

1 A person who violates this section is guilty of a misdemeanor and on (c) 2 conviction is subject to a fine not exceeding: 3 [\$300] **\$1,000** for a first violation; (1) [\$1,000] **\$2,000** for a second violation occurring within 2 years 4 **(2)** after the first violation; and 5 6 [\$3,000] **\$6,000** for each subsequent violation occurring within 2 (3) 7 years after the preceding violation. For purposes of this section, each separate incident at a different time 8 (d) 9 and occasion is a separate violation. 10 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 11 October 1, 2011.
