BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, Article – Tax – Property Section 3–103(a) and (c) Annotated Code of Maryland (2007 Replacement Volume and 2010 Supplement) SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: Article - Tax - Property 3-103. **(I)** [Each] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBPARAGRAPH (II) OF (a) (1) THIS PARAGRAPH, EACH board consists of 3 regular members and 1 alternate member.
