### 1 AN ACT concerning

# State Commission of Real Estate Appraisers and Home Inspectors – Home Inspectors – Continuing Professional Competency

FOR the purpose of requiring the State Commission of Real Estate Appraisers and 4  $\mathbf{5}$ Home Inspectors to adopt regulations to require a demonstration of continuing 6 professional competency of a certain number of educational hours as a condition 7 of renewal of a license to provide home inspection services; providing for the 8 implementation of the continuing professional competency requirement on a 9 phased-in basis; providing that certain educational hours from courses offered by certain entities satisfy the continuing professional competency requirement 10 *under certain circumstances*; and generally relating to the State Commission of 11 12 Real Estate Appraisers and Home Inspectors.
