AN ACT concerning 1

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Maryland Electric Vehicle Infrastructure Council

- 3 FOR the purpose of establishing the Maryland Electric Vehicle Infrastructure Council; 4 specifying the membership and staffing of the Council; requiring the Governor 5 to designate the chair or cochairs of the Council; requiring the Council to 6 perform certain duties and make certain recommendations; prohibiting 7 members of the Council from receiving certain compensation, but authorizing 8 the reimbursement of certain expenses; requiring the Council to submit an 9 interim and a final report by certain dates; defining certain terms; providing for the termination of this Act; and generally relating to the Maryland Electric 10 Vehicle Infrastructure Council. 11
- 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 13 MARYLAND, That:
- In this section, "electric vehicle" or "EV" means any mode of electric drive 14 (a) transportation. 15

- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2011. It shall remain effective for a period of 2 years and, at the end of June 30, 2013, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
