15 16	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
17	Article - Education

19 20 21	(b) (1) For the purposes of this section other than subsection (c), the Board of Public Works shall define by regulation what constitutes an eligible and ineligible public school construction or capital improvement cost.
22	(2) (i) The Board of Public Works shall include modular

construction as an approved public school construction or capital IMPROVEMENT cost.

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$\frac{1}{2}$	(ii) The Board of Public Works, at the recommendation of the Interagency Committee on School Construction, shall adopt regulations that:

4 5 6	2. Establish the minimum specifications required for approval of modular construction as a public school construction or capital improvement cost.
7 8 9	(3) (I) THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS SHALL INCLUDE PLANNING AND DESIGN AS AN APPROVED PUBLIC SCHOOL CONSTRUCTION OR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT COST.
10 11 12	(II) THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS, AT THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE INTERAGENCY COMMITTEE ON SCHOOL CONSTRUCTION, SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS THAT:
13	1. DEFINE PLANNING AND DESIGN; AND
14 15 16	2. ESTABLISH THE MINIMUM SPECIFICATIONS REQUIRED FOR APPROVAL OF PLANNING AND DESIGN AS A PUBLIC SCHOOL CONSTRUCTION OR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT COST.
17 18	[(3)] (4) The cost of acquiring land may not be considered a construction or capital improvement cost and may not be paid by the State.
19 20 21 22	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section 1 of this Act shall apply to the construction of new schools that have not initiated a Request For Proposal for the selection of an architectural and engineering consultant on or before June 1, 2011.
23 24 25 26	SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 2011. It shall remain effective for a period of 3 years and, at the end of May 31, 2014, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
