### **SENATE BILL 202**

1 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, this Act shall take 2 effect October 1, 1996. It shall remain effective for a period of [15] **20** years and, at 3 the end of September 30, [2011] **2016**, with no further action required by the General 4 Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.
