BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 14 15 **Article - Health Occupations** 16 13-101. - 2 (a) A person who violates any provision of this title is guilty of a misdemeanor and on conviction is subject to a fine not exceeding [\$5,000] **\$10,000** or imprisonment not exceeding 3 years or both.
- 5 (b) (1) Any person who violates § 13–401 of this subtitle is subject to a 6 civil fine of not more than \$50,000 to be assessed by the Board.
- 7 (2) The Board shall pay any penalty collected under this subsection 8 into the State Board of Physical Therapy Examiners Fund.
- 9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 10 October 1, 2011.
