- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 17 (a) (1) The Department shall develop and implement juvenile services 18 educational programs at all residential facilities of the Department of Juvenile 19 Services by July 1, [2014] **2012**.
- 20 (2) This subsection does not prohibit the Department from contracting with a private party to provide educational services for students with special needs under the control and general management of the Department.
- 23 (b) On or before February 1, 2006, and every other year thereafter until 24 [2014] **2012**, the Department shall report to the Governor and, in accordance with §

- 2 implementation of this subtitle, including:
- 3 (1) The identification of all residential facilities for which the 4 Department has assumed responsibility for the educational services; and
