A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Frederick County – Board of Education – Alien Students**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Frederick County Board of Education, on or before a
4 certain date of each school year, to make a good faith effort to provide the Board
5 of County Commissioners for Frederick County with the total number of
6 students in the Frederick County public school system whose presence in the
7 United States cannot be reasonably documented; prohibiting the Board of
8 Education from associating a student's race, appearance, language, or name
9 with citizenship or immigration status; and generally relating to students in the
10 Frederick County public school system.

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 **Article – Education**

19 **3–5B–06.**

20 **(A) ON OR BEFORE MARCH 1 OF EACH SCHOOL YEAR, THE FREDERICK**
21 **COUNTY BOARD SHALL MAKE A GOOD FAITH EFFORT TO PROVIDE THE BOARD**
22 **OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS FOR FREDERICK COUNTY WITH THE NUMBER OF**
23 **STUDENTS ENROLLED IN THE FREDERICK COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEM IN**
24 **THAT SCHOOL YEAR WHOSE LAWFUL PRESENCE IN THE UNITED STATES**
25 **CANNOT BE REASONABLY DOCUMENTED.**

1 **(B) THE FREDERICK COUNTY BOARD MAY NOT ASSOCIATE A**
2 **STUDENT'S RACE, APPEARANCE, LANGUAGE, OR NAME WITH CITIZENSHIP OR**
3 **IMMIGRATION STATUS.**

4 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
5 June 1, 2011.
