- 20 (A) ON OR BEFORE MARCH 1 OF EACH SCHOOL YEAR, THE FREDERICK 21 COUNTY BOARD SHALL MAKE A GOOD FAITH EFFORT TO PROVIDE THE BOARD
- 22 OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS FOR FREDERICK COUNTY WITH THE NUMBER OF
- 23 STUDENTS ENROLLED IN THE FREDERICK COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEM IN
- 24 THAT SCHOOL YEAR WHOSE LAWFUL PRESENCE IN THE UNITED STATES
- 25 CANNOT BE REASONABLY DOCUMENTED.



- 1 (B) THE FREDERICK COUNTY BOARD MAY NOT ASSOCIATE A STUDENT'S RACE, APPEARANCE, LANGUAGE, OR NAME WITH CITIZENSHIP OR IMMIGRATION STATUS.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 2011.
