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A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

Gas Companies and Electric Companies – Service Quality and Reliability Standards

4 FOR the purpose of requiring the Public Service Commission to establish certain 5 service quality and reliability standards for gas companies and electric 6 companies; providing for the application of regulations adopted under this Act; 7 requiring the standards to include certain benchmarks; requiring the 8 Commission to use certain national standards to the extent feasible; authorizing 9 the Commission to require gas companies and electric companies to supply 10 certain data for certain purposes; requiring gas companies and electric companies to file a certain annual report with the Commission containing 11 12 certain information; authorizing the Commission to impose a certain penalty 13 against a gas company or an electric company that fails to meet certain 14 standards; prohibiting a certain penalty from being passed on to ratepayers; 15 authorizing the Commission to adopt certain regulations; defining a certain 16 term; and generally relating to service quality and reliability standards for gas 17 companies and electric companies.

- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
 - Article Public Utilities

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1	(A) IN THIS SECTION, "STANDARDS" MEANS THE SERVICE QUALITY AND
2	RELIABILITY STANDARDS FOR GAS COMPANIES AND ELECTRIC COMPANIES
3	ESTABLISHED BY THE COMMISSION UNDER THIS SECTION.

- 4 (B) REGULATIONS ADOPTED UNDER THIS SECTION MAY NOT APPLY TO 5 ELECTRIC COOPERATIVES OR GAS COOPERATIVES.
- 6 (C) (1) THE COMMISSION SHALL BY REGULATION ESTABLISH
 7 SERVICE QUALITY AND RELIABILITY STANDARDS FOR GAS COMPANIES AND
 8 ELECTRIC COMPANIES GOVERNING THE DELIVERY OF GAS AND ELECTRICITY TO
 9 RETAIL CUSTOMERS.
- 10 (2) THE STANDARDS SHALL INCLUDE BENCHMARKS FOR:
- 11 (I) SERVICE OUTAGES;
- 12 (II) CUSTOMER SATISFACTION;
- 13 (III) DISTRIBUTION AND TRANSMISSION FACILITY
- 14 **UPGRADES**;

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- 15 (IV) REPAIRS AND MAINTENANCE;
- 16 (V) STAFFING LEVELS;
- 17 (VI) TELEPHONE SERVICE;
- 18 (VII) BILLING SERVICE; AND
- 19 (VIII) PUBLIC SAFETY.
- 20 **(3)** THE COMMISSION SHALL USE EXISTING NATIONAL 21 STANDARDS TO THE EXTENT FEASIBLE.
- 22 (D) THE COMMISSION MAY REQUIRE EACH GAS COMPANY AND 23 ELECTRIC COMPANY TO SUPPLY DATA TO ASSIST THE COMMISSION IN 24 DEVELOPING AND MEASURING COMPLIANCE WITH THE STANDARDS.
- 25 (E) (1) EACH GAS COMPANY AND ELECTRIC COMPANY SHALL FILE AN 26 ANNUAL REPORT WITH THE COMMISSION BY THE DATE REQUIRED BY THE 27 COMMISSION.
 - (2) A REPORT FILED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION SHALL INCLUDE:

1	(I) A COMPARISON OF THE GAS COMPANY'S OR ELECTRI
2	OMPANY'S PERFORMANCE IN THE PREVIOUS CALENDAR YEAR TO THE SERVIO
3	UALITY AND RELIABILITY STANDARDS;

- 4 (II) A DESCRIPTION OF FUTURE ACTIONS AND PROJECTS
 5 PLANNED TO ENSURE COMPLIANCE WITH THE STANDARDS; AND
- 6 (III) ANY SUPPORTING DATA REQUIRED BY THE 7 COMMISSION.
- 8 (F) (1) THE COMMISSION MAY IMPOSE A PENALTY AGAINST A GAS
 9 COMPANY OR AN ELECTRIC COMPANY THAT FAILS TO MEET THE APPLICABLE
 10 SERVICE QUALITY AND RELIABILITY STANDARDS IN AN AMOUNT NOT
 11 EXCEEDING 10% OF THE GAS COMPANY'S OR ELECTRIC COMPANY'S
 12 TRANSMISSION AND DISTRIBUTION REVENUES FOR THE PREVIOUS CALENDAR
 13 YEAR.
- 14 **(2)** A PENALTY IMPOSED UNDER PARAGRAPH **(1)** OF THIS SUBSECTION MAY NOT BE PASSED ON TO RATEPAYERS.
- 16 (G) THE COMMISSION MAY ADOPT REGULATIONS NECESSARY TO CARRY
 17 OUT THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION, INCLUDING METHODS FOR GATHERING
 18 DATA.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2011.
