2 **Hart–Miller–Pleasure Island Citizens Oversight Committee – Duties**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the duties of the Hart–Miller–Pleasure Island Citizens
4 Oversight Committee; requiring the Oversight Committee to monitor and
5 provide oversight for certain development, use, and maintenance of the
6 Hart–Miller–Pleasure Island chain; requiring the Oversight Committee to hear
7 and dispose of complaints by certain individuals; and generally relating to the
8 Hart–Miller–Pleasure Island Citizens Oversight Committee.

19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
20 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

21 **Article – Environment**

2 (a) (1) With the advice and consent of the Senate, the Governor shall
3 appoint a Hart-Miller-Pleasure Island Citizens Oversight Committee.

4 (c) The Oversight Committee shall:

5 (1) [Monitor the redeposit of spoil and Baltimore County tributary
6 spoil within 5 miles of the Hart-Miller-Pleasure Island chain] **MONITOR AND
7 PROVIDE OVERSIGHT REGARDING:**

8 (i) **THE FUTURE DEVELOPMENT, USE, AND MAINTENANCE
9 OF THE HART-MILLER-PLEASURE ISLAND CHAIN; AND**

10 (ii) **THE WATER QUALITY IMMEDIATELY SURROUNDING THE
11 ISLANDS; and**

12 (2) Hear and dispose of complaints lodged by individuals affected by
13 [the redeposit of spoil and Baltimore County tributary spoil within 5 miles of the
14 Hart-Miller-Pleasure Island chain] **THE FUTURE DEVELOPMENT AND THE WATER
15 QUALITY IMMEDIATELY SURROUNDING THE HART-MILLER-PLEASURE ISLAND
16 CHAIN.**

17 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
18 October 1, 2011.
