A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Washington County – Alcoholic Beverages – Wine Festival License

3 FOR the purpose of establishing a special wine festival (WF) license in Washington 4 County; requiring that an applicant for a special WF license must be a holder of $\mathbf{5}$ a certain other license; specifying that a holder of a special WF license may 6 display and sell wine in a certain manner; requiring the Washington County $\mathbf{7}$ Board of License Commissioners to assure that the primary focus of the Festival 8 is the promotion of Maryland wine; requiring a holder of a special WF license to 9 display and sell certain wine; providing for a license fee; providing that this Act does not prohibit the holder of a special WF license from holding another 10 11 alcoholic beverages license; authorizing the Board to choose certain weekends 12for festivals: requiring the Board to choose certain locations for the festivals: 13requiring the Board to adopt certain regulations; defining certain terms; and 14 generally relating to wine in Washington County.

That the Laws of Maryland 1 read as follows: $\mathbf{2}$ 3 Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages 4 8-313.1. $\mathbf{5}$ (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE 6 **MEANINGS INDICATED.** "BOARD" MEANS THE WASHINGTON COUNTY BOARD OF (2) 7 LICENSE COMMISSIONERS. 8 9 "FESTIVAL" MEANS THE WASHINGTON COUNTY WINE (3) FESTIVAL. 10 THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY IN WASHINGTON COUNTY. 11 **(B)** 12(C) THE BOARD MAY ISSUE A SPECIAL WINE FESTIVAL (WF) LICENSE. 13 (D) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF THIS ARTICLE, TO 14BE ELIGIBLE FOR A SPECIAL WF LICENSE, AN APPLICANT MUST BE A HOLDER OF AN EXISTING STATE RETAIL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES LICENSE, A STATE 1516 CLASS 3 WINERY LICENSE, OR A STATE CLASS 4 LIMITED WINERY LICENSE. A SPECIAL WF LICENSE ENTITLES THE HOLDER TO DISPLAY AND 17**(E)** SELL AT RETAIL WINE FOR CONSUMPTION ON OR OFF THE PREMISES ON THE 18 DAYS AND FOR THE HOURS DESIGNATED FOR THE FESTIVAL IN THE COUNTY. 19 THE BOARD SHALL ASSURE THAT THE PRIMARY FOCUS OF 20**(F)** (1) 21THE FESTIVAL IS THE PROMOTION OF MARYLAND WINE. 22A HOLDER OF A SPECIAL WF LICENSE SHALL DISPLAY AND (2) SELL WINE THAT IS DISTRIBUTED IN THE STATE. 2324(G) THE SPECIAL WF LICENSE FEE IS \$20. 25THIS SECTION DOES NOT PROHIBIT THE HOLDER OF A SPECIAL WF **(H)** 26LICENSE FROM HOLDING ANOTHER ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES LICENSE OF A 27DIFFERENT CLASS OR NATURE. THE BOARD MAY CHOOSE 2 WEEKENDS ANNUALLY FOR THE 28**(I)** 29FESTIVALS.

1 (J) THE BOARD SHALL CHOOSE LOCATIONS IN THE COUNTY FOR THE 2 FESTIVALS THAT ARE NOT LICENSED UNDER THIS ARTICLE.

3 (K) THE BOARD SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT THIS 4 SECTION.

5 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 6 July 1, 2011.
