3 FOR the purpose of creating a liquor tasting license in Carroll County; authorizing the Board of License Commissioners for Carroll County to issue the liquor tasting 4 5 license only to holders of a certain alcoholic beverages license; specifying that 6 the liquor tasting license authorizes consumption of certain liquor for tasting or 7 sampling purposes only; requiring that the liquor be provided to consumers at 8 no charge; specifying certain limitations on the quantity of liquor that may be 9 consumed; providing an annual fee; specifying the term of a liquor tasting 10 license; authorizing the Board to adopt regulations; defining a certain term; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages in Carroll County. 11

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 18

- 1 (B) IN THIS SECTION, "BOARD" MEANS THE BOARD OF LICENSE 2 COMMISSIONERS FOR CARROLL COUNTY.
- 3 (C) THE BOARD MAY APPROVE THE ISSUANCE OF A LIQUOR TASTING 4 LICENSE.
- 5 (D) THE LIQUOR TASTING LICENSE MAY BE ISSUED ONLY TO HOLDERS 6 OF A CLASS A BEER, WINE AND LIQUOR LICENSE.
- 7 (E) (1) THE LIQUOR TASTING LICENSE AUTHORIZES THE 8 CONSUMPTION OF LIQUOR AUTHORIZED TO BE SOLD BY THE BEER, WINE AND 9 LIQUOR LICENSE HOLDER FOR TASTING OR SAMPLING PURPOSES ONLY.
- 10 (2) TO HOLD A LIQUOR TASTING, A HOLDER OF A LIQUOR 11 TASTING LICENSE SHALL PROVIDE LIQUOR TO CONSUMERS AT NO CHARGE.
- 12 **(F)** A PERSON MAY CONSUME LIQUOR AT A LIQUOR TASTING IN A 13 QUANTITY NOT EXCEEDING:
- 14 (1) ONE-HALF OUNCE FROM A SINGLE SAMPLE OF LIQUOR; AND
- 15 (2) FIVE SAMPLES IN A SINGLE DAY.
- 16 (G) THE ANNUAL FEE FOR THE LIQUOR TASTING LICENSE IS \$100.
- 17 (H) A LIQUOR TASTING LICENSE IS VALID FOR NOT MORE THAN 52 DAYS 18 A YEAR AND MAY BE USED ON CONSECUTIVE OR NONCONSECUTIVE DAYS.
- 19 (I) THE BOARD MAY ADOPT REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT THIS 20 SECTION.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2011.
